March 16, 2021 at 7 p.m.

Call to Order: Chairman Jim Heizler called the meeting to order at 7 p.m. Present Supervisor Paul Precour. Also present was Clerk Treasurer Marcie Bogdanovic. There were 22 visitors.

Approval of Minutes from the February 16, 2021 Regular Town Board Meeting: Motion by Paul Precour, second by Jim Heizler and carried to approve the minutes from the regular town meeting as presented.

Donated Computer, Monitor, Printer: It was announced that Paul Precour donated a computer, printer, and monitor to the Town of Worcester.
